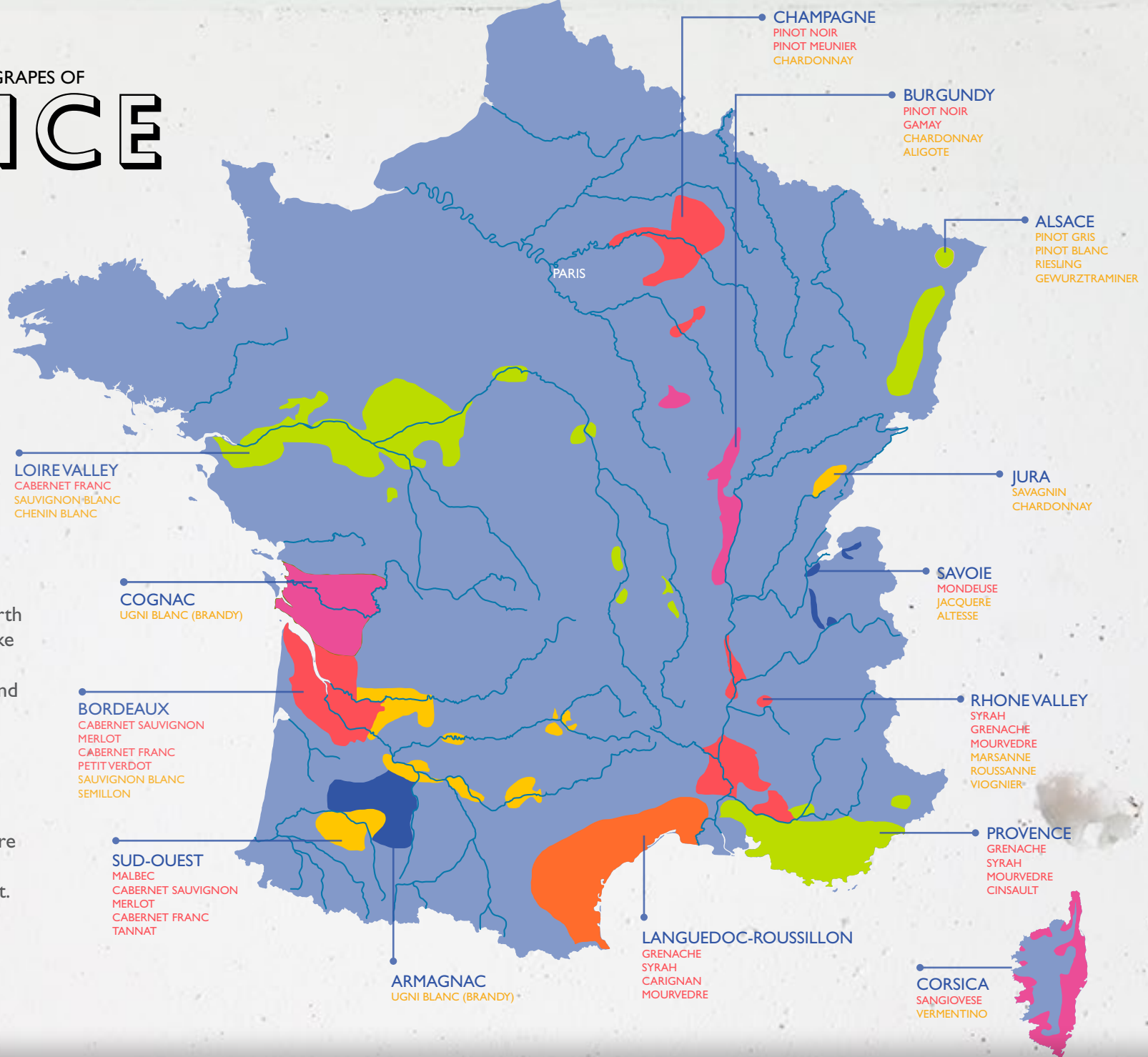


WINE REGIONS AND GRAPES OF FRANCE



Freezing Champagne is so far north only white wines thrive, rather like Chablis (Chardonnay), the Loire (Sauvignon and Chenin Blancs), and Alsace (aromatics).

Burgundy is chilly but Pinot Noir lives here - slightly north of Rhone's Syrah and Bordeaux's Cabernet - while further south are the many full-bodied reds of France's hot, Mediterranean coast.
