A moderate maritime climate, New Zealand is best suited to white wines and fruity reds. Marlborough makes famous Sauvignon Blanc, with excellent aromatics and Pinot Noir. Central Otago is similar but emphasises Pinot, like other southerly regions Waipara, Nelson and Wairarapa. Warmer North Island regions Hawkes Bay and Auckland do well with Chardonnay and Bordeaux and Syrah reds.
